Key signature: one sharp (F#). The system shows the E major triad in its root position and two inversions. The notes are E, G#, and B.

e: i V<sub>2</sub><sup>4</sup> i<sup>6</sup> i V<sub>3</sub><sup>4</sup> i

Key signature: two flats (Bb, F). The system shows the Bb major triad in its root position and two inversions. The notes are Bb, D, and F.

Bb: I V<sub>3</sub><sup>6</sup> I I V<sub>3</sub><sup>4</sup> I<sup>6</sup>
